

# Visit to Bullswool Farm

## SCHEDULE:

Please note: this is an approximate timetable and may vary from group to group, depending on time available and visit objectives.

### 10.00am: Arrival time

Morning tea on arrival. School is directed to seating area. If weather is wet, morning tea is eaten in the Sheepshed.

### 10.20: Welcome talk

Discussion with children about animal interaction, OSH rules discussed. Explanation of how visit works, and different food cups.

### 10.30

Children enter the farm park's green zone (shown on map). They are each given a green cup of animal food suitable for the animals in this area.

### 10.50

Children given feeder scoops and an orange cup of animal food, and enter Orange Zone. This area has our larger animals, and our Play Paddock. The feeder scoops ensure that children can safely feed every animal.

### 12.00

Return to morning tea area to have lunch

### 12.30

Visit farm's museums.

### 1.20

Pink Zone

The children get their final cup of animal food, and feed the miniature horses in the Pink Zone.

### 1.45 - 2.00pm

Start preparing to leave.

\*\*\* Bush Reserve\*\*\* The Bush Reserve walk takes about 30 minutes. The Farm Park offers quite a big day for Year 1 & 2 Students, so we recommend that only older groups include the Bush Reserve in their itinerary.
